Climb the Gloucester Lookout Tree and explore the five National Parks surrounding Pemberton on the Karri Forest Explorer Drive.

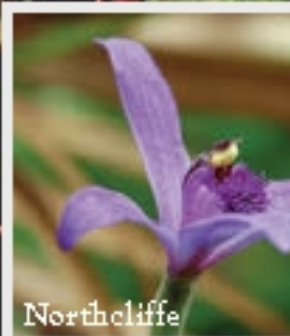
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
